The easiest way to get to BC is by the T (the MBTA system) to take the D
Reservoir Station, go upstairs to street level and take the BC Shuttle bus to
morning and evening commuter hours). Shuttle bus schedules are published on
the website of the Office of Grand and Transportation Services.

The shuttle ride to campus takes about 10-12 minutes, making several stops
at various stops west of campus. If you are coming from the airport, you will
make campus, but you will have to walk a short distance to the parking
structure. You can also take the elevator in the parking structure just after the
this stop. To get to the parking structure, take the elevator to the 1st floor, 1000 ft and

you could take the D/Riverside trolley one more stop to the Chestnut Hill station
and walk to campus: it will take about 15 minutes (one goes along Hammond
Street, straight ahead as you leave the T station) until you hit Beacon Street
where you will see the BC campus before you.

Please Note: one could also take the "B" ("Boston College") trolley of the Green
line and get off at the last stop (across the street from St. Ignatius Church) and
then walk uphill to the Main Gates on Commonwealth Ave. or else walk to
parking structure and take elevator as described in previous paragraph.

However, the B line makes numerous local stops, while the D line is an express
line.
